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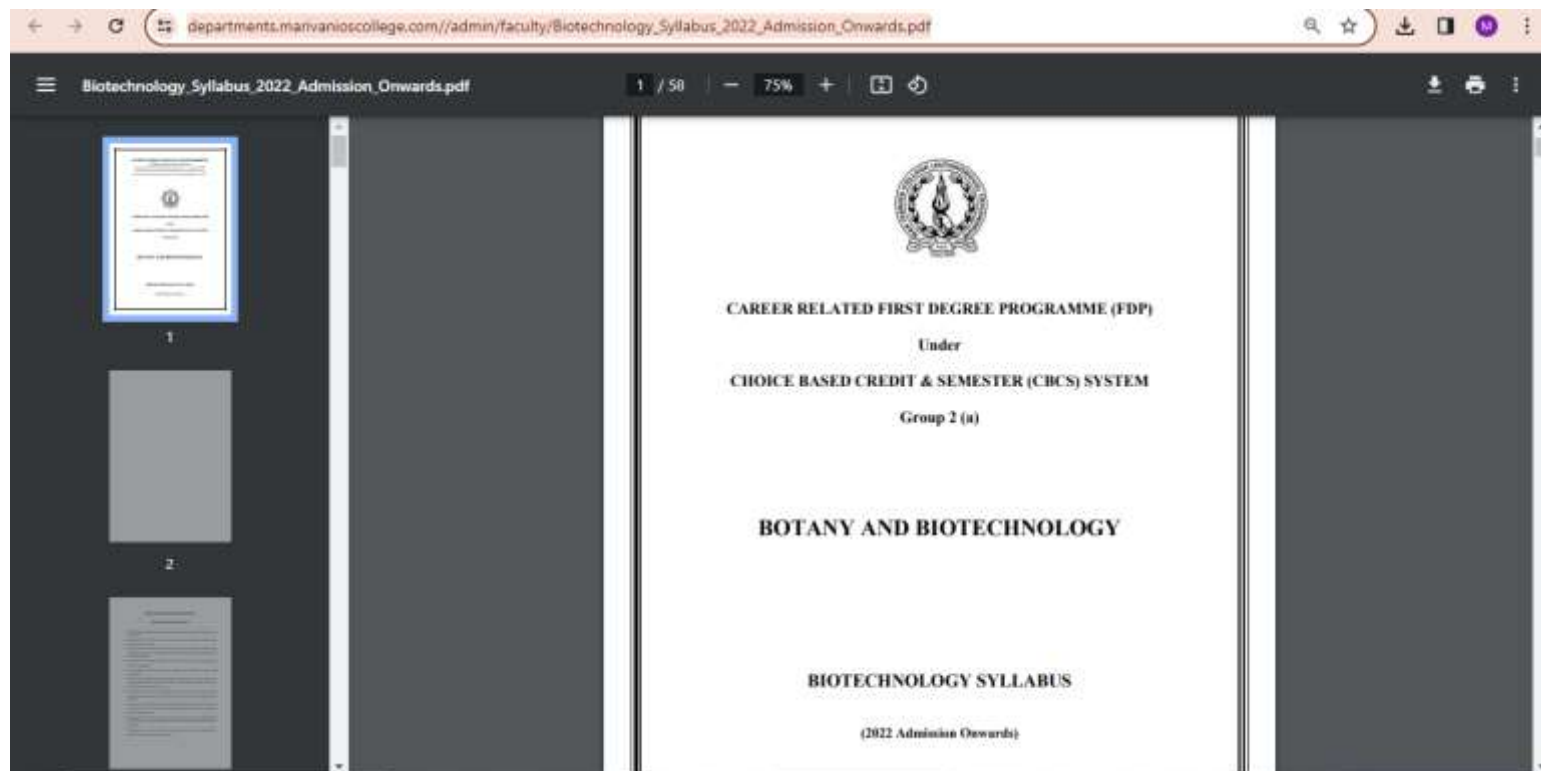

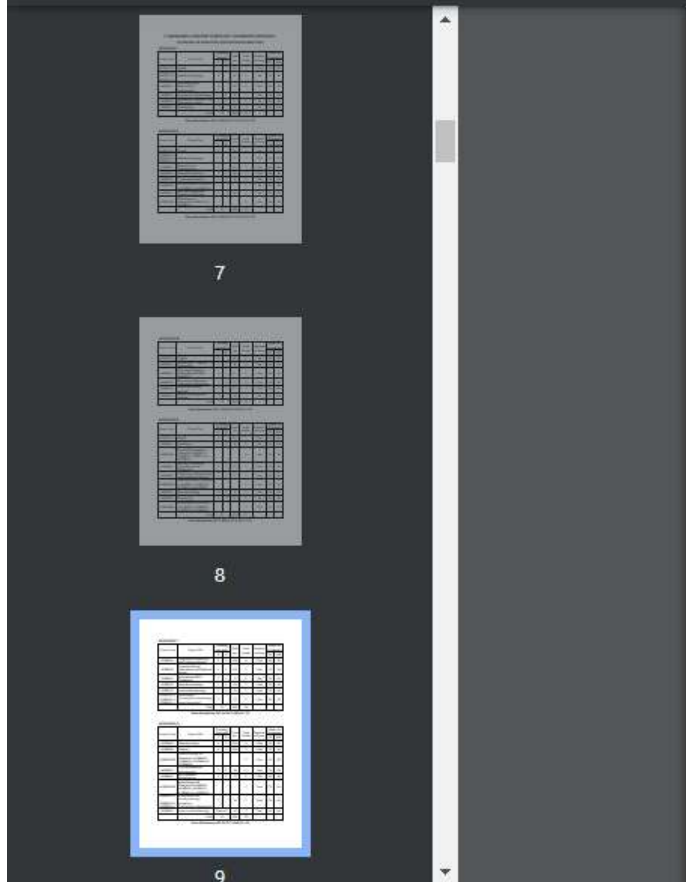

IX. PROJECT / DISSERTATION WORK

For each First Degree Programme there shall be a Project/Dissertation work. The Project/Dissertation work can be done either individually or by a group not exceeding eight students. However, Viva- Voce based on the Project/Dissertation work shall be conducted individually. The students are allowed to do project work outside the college only in recognized government institutes or laboratories.

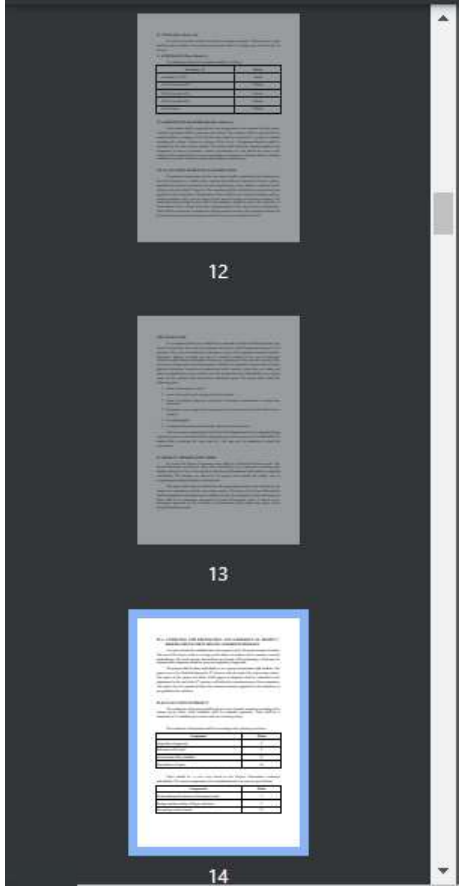
The topics shall either be allotted by the supervising teacher or be selected by the students in consultation with the supervising teacher. The report of the Project/Dissertation shall be submitted to the Department in duplicate before the completion of the sixth semester. There shall be no continuous assessment for Project/Dissertation work. A Board of two Examiners appointed by the Controller of Examination shall evaluate the report of the Project/Dissertation work.



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IX.A. GUIDELINES FOR PREPARATION AND SUBMISSION OF PROJECT / DISSERTATION IN FDP IN BOTANY AND BIOTECHNOLOGY

As a part of study the candidate has to do a project work. The project carries 4 credits. The aim of the Project work is to bring out the talents of students and to introduce research methodology. The work may be chosen from any branch of Biotechnology, which may be Experimental. Emphasis should be given for originality of approach.

The project shall be done individually or as a group of maximum eight students. The projects are to be identified during the 4th semester with the help of the supervising teacher. The report of the project (of about 30-40 pages) in duplicate shall be submitted to the department by the end of the 6th semester well before the commencement of the examination. The reports are to be produced before the external examiners appointed by the institution as per guidelines for valuation.

IX.B. EVALUATION OF PROJECT

The evaluation of the project shall be done by two external examiners according to the scheme given below. Each candidate shall be evaluated separately. There shall be a maximum of 15 candidates per session with two sessions per day.

The evaluation of dissertation shall be according to the scheme given below.

GUIDELINES FOR PROJECT COURSE (Course Code AUCH646)

- The board of examiners can decide the scheme of evaluation of project , study tour report and viva voce
- Topics of chemical interest can be selected for the project. Project is to be done by a group not exceeding 5 students on approval by the teacher in charge.
- Every student should submit typed (A4 paper, 12 Font, 1.5 Space, 20- 30 pages), spirally bind project report duly attested by the supervising teacher and the Head of the Department on the day of practical examination before a board of two Examiners for ESE.
- The viva-voce based on the project is conducted individually.
- Project topic once chosen shall not be repeated by any later batches of students.

- List of projects submitted year wise is to be maintained in a register and submitted before the examiners if necessary.

1. Preliminary (Title page, declaration, certificate of the supervising teacher, content etc.)

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6.1 Each student shall present a seminar in each course in each semester on a topic/area allotted.

6.2 Seminar presentations shall be done in the respective class room itself so as to benefit all the students. The interaction of the entire class is expected during the seminar presentations.

6.3 Seminars shall be evaluated on the basis of the quality of the presentation, content, interaction etc. The evaluation shall be done by the concerned teacher of the faculty who handles the topic/course.

NB: All the records of the continuous assessment must be kept in the department and be made available for verification by the concerned authorities, if necessary.

7. Project Evaluation

Dissertation/Project submitted at the end of the fourth semester will be valued by a Board of Examiners appointed and constituted by the Controller of Examinations. The maximum marks for the project/dissertation shall be 50, of which 10 marks shall be allotted to the Viva-voce examination, which shall be conducted along with the comprehensive examination.

Marks awarded for the Project in a particular year shall be combined with the marks awarded for the project-based viva voce conducted at subsequent appearance as a special case as per the recommendations of the College PG Monitoring Committee.

Project Work:

Every student is required to undertake a project **either individually or in a group of not more than 5 under the supervision of a teacher** and a report of the same have to be submitted at least 15 days before the commencement of 6th end semester examination. The project work may commence in the 5th semester. The project can be done by using either primary data or secondary data. The topics shall either be allotted by the supervising teacher or be selected by the students in consultation with the supervising teacher.

The project work shall have the following stages:

- Project proposal presentation and preliminary study- **5th Semester**
- Field work and data analysis –**6th Semester**
- Report writing, presentation and Final report Submission–**6th Semester**

As part of the requirements for BA Programme , every student must do a project either individually or as a group under the supervision of a teacher. The project is expected to equip the student to identify an issue or topic and conduct the study in a systematic and scientific way. Students will get the opportunity to apply various tools they have learned and present the report in a structured manner.

Guidelines

1. Project work may be done individually or as a group (Maximum 5 students). The topic selected should be related to theory or economic issues. The work may use primary or secondary source of data. It should be typed in 35- 60 pages with spiral binding. The printing has to be in paper A4, with Times New Roman font 12 for content and 14 for titles with a line spacing 1.5.
2. The guidance for doing the project has to be given in the V Semester and VI Semester. Three instructional hours in each semester have been provided for this purpose.
3. The area of study should be finalized in the V Semester and final report should be submitted at the end of the VI semester.
4. A pre submission Seminar should be undertaken in the VI Semester for reviewing nature and quality of the project work. The supervising teacher should ensure that the work is not a reproduction of any work conducted earlier.
5. Students should be given classes on research methodology before the commencement of the project work.
6. The project Work shall contain the following :

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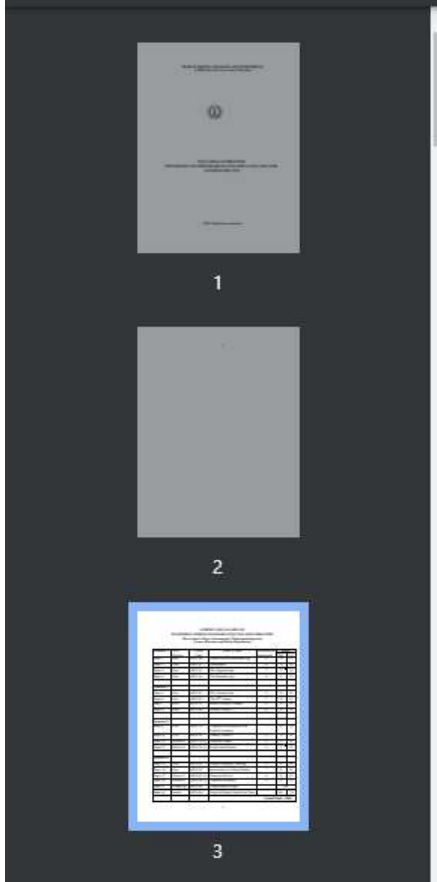
