ANNUAL REPORT OF EXAMINATIONS CONDUCTED DURING THE ACADEMIC YEAR 2022–23

During the academic year 2022–23 the office of the Controller of Examination (CoE) notified the various End Semester Examinations for different programmes based on academic schedule and conducted the examinations successfully. The CoE office carried out the examination works under the guidance of the Principal and in accordance with the suggestions of the statutory bodies of the College. The major phases of Conduct of examination process are notification conduct, valuation of answer scripts, declaration of results, and issue of mark sheets. The same were completed successfully for the academic year 2022-2023 in a time bound manner.

The End Semester Examinations (ESE) for the UG and the PG Degree Programmes of Mar Ivanios College (Autonomous) were conducted during the period 2022–2023 as per the table noted below. The Examinations were conducted for the regular/improvement/reappearance candidates. The examinations were notified at least 30 working days prior to the commencement of Examinations.

During the conduct of the End Semester Examinations, Internal and external malpractice squads were constituted to ensure fair conduct of Examinations. CCTV Cameras are fixed in the Auditorium, where most of the students write their End Semester Examinations. A total of 30 malpractice cases were reported and were disposed-off after a hearing conducted by the Students Disciplinary Committee with due disciplinary actions recommended by the committee. As result of the disciplinary action, the examination for the course for which the candidate resorted to malpractice in the particular semester along with the rest of the examinations in that semester stand cancelled.

False numbering is adapted to ensure confidentiality in valuation. Barcoding system was introduced for P.G. Valuation from 2022 academic year on words. 50 % of the UG answer scripts were valued by internal examiners while external examiners were engaged for the rest. All the Answer scripts are subject to Chief valuation where by 20 % of the answer scripts are revalued by chief examiner. A centralized valuation camp was conducted during May 2023 to expedite the valuation process. As per guidelines for PG programmes double valuation system is adopted with one internal valuation and the second external valuation. The End Semester Examination results are approved for publication by the Governing Council after considering the statistics of results presented by the Controller of Examinations. The Statistics of results is presented incorporating the recommendations of the respective Pass Boards. A table of overall results is presented below:
