As part of the state wide launching a massive anti-drug movement called 'No to Drugs'. The Honorable Chief Minister of Kerala Shri. # Programme 1-State Level Drug Abuse Awareness Month Date: 06 October 2022, Mar Gregorious Hall, Mar Ivanios College

The official inauguration of the state level drug abuse awareness campaign of 2022," Vimukthi" was held at 10am by the Hon'ble Chief Minister of Kerala, Sri Pinarayi Vijayan through the Victer's Channel which was preceded by the official inauguration held at Mar Ivanios College. The function was presided by Principal, Prof. Dr.Jijimon K Thomas. The Vice Principal, Dr Shirley Stewart. Sri Johnson Joseph, Trivandrum corporation councillor, Prof. Dr. Gladston Raj the Vice President of the Parent Teachers Association and Fr. Soji M, the Bursar offered their felicitations. 

### Programme 2- Awareness Session Date 07 October 2022

An awareness session was organised and Sri Jayaraj PK(Assistant Excise Commissioner and Vimukthi District Manager TVM) was the key note speaker. The NSS Unit has conducted the Awareness Session for all the students of our college on 7th October 2022 at the College Basketball court in connection with the Anti-Drug Awareness Campaign. The session helped the students to become self-aware about the harmful effects of drug abuse and also highlighted the disastrous consequences of the narcotic drugs and psychotropic substances.

### **Programme 3 - Street Play and Folk Song**

The National Service Scheme Unit of our college has organised a street play and folk song programme for creating awareness on drug abuse among the students in our college. This programme was held on 10 October 2022 at the College Basketball court. The event was successful and it generated attention among the students about drug abuse and its malicious effects. The communication of the central idea of drugs abuse, relayed through the street play in an informal manner was effective in driving the message.





### Programme 4 - Anti Drugs Quiz Competition Date 12. October 2022

A quiz competition as part of the drug abuse awareness campaign was conducted for the NSS volunteers on 12th October 2022. Many students participated and , the first and second prize were won by Dona Mercy Kurian and Ashish K Shintu. The objective of conducting the quiz program was also for

communicating the perils of drug abuse through mediums which the students can relate easily to and towards generating a reciprocal dialogue.



### Programme 5 - Drug Abuse Awareness - Speech Date 13 October 2022

For making awareness on drug abuse, a session was arranged for NSS volunteers on 13th October 2022.In that programme a speech was delivered by one of the NSS volunteers Hima Sara Reji.



### Programme 6 - Just A Minute Competition Date 14 October 2022

A 'Just A Minute' (JAM) Competition was conducted for NSS volunteers on 14th October 2022. The topic was related to the influence of social media on drug abuse. A team of two volunteers had participated from each group and the team which did the best presentation had won the first position. The idea behind the competition was to generate awareness among the student community towards various channels and means of online or digital communication where the implicit threat of normalization of drug use exists to which students could become susceptible, if they are not made aware of.



### **Programme 7 - Awareness Sessions**

Every year, the college conducts orientation programmes to our fresh Graduate and Post Graduate students. During the current academic year, we have focused our central theme of the orientation programme as "Anti-Drug awareness". Accordingly, on 30 September 2022, we conducted one full-day awareness session for our students. The forenoon sessions were handled by ADGP Padmakumar IPS. He has been sharing the basic reasons of the drug abuse and shared a video presentation on drug addiction. 125 students attended that session. In the afternoon session the Assistant commissioner of Excise, IB Kozhikode Mr. Y Shibu shared his experience and illustrated the news reports and various incidents regarding drug addiction.





# About the College

KSMDB College, Sasthamcotta, established in 1964 in Kunnathur taluk, takes its place in the annals of the history of South Kerala as a revered institution for higher education managed by the Hon'ble Travancore Devaswom Board, and affiliated to the University of Kerala. In connection with Gandhi Jayanthi, an intercollegiate essay writing competition was conducted on 17/10/2022.





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
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### CANCER AWARENESS PROGRAMME.

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
### **Saving Schemes Talk**


Talk on Health and Hygiene

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






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


### International Women's day –Walkathon

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




## Report on PLEDGE AGAINST DRUG ABUSE








# Report of the activities of the Debate Club, Mar Ivanios College (Autonomous), 2021-22


### Report of the activities of the Debate Club, Mar Ivanios College






### **Orientation Programme**


The session was concluded by 12:30 in the afternoon. The club has decided to conduct activies to develop the skills of the members in various areas.


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### World AIDS Day (1st December)
