Introduction

Mar Ivanios College owes its existence to the far-sighted vision of the Servant of God Archbishop Mar Ivanios of Trivandrum. Started in June 1949 as a College affiliated to the University of Travancore, it stands affiliated to the University of Kerala since 1957. The college offers 11 under graduate programmes and 7 P.G. programmes. The College has been re-assessed and reaccredited with 'A' Grade by NAAC in its fourth cycle of reaccreditation process and will appear for the next accreditation in 2024. It is the first private college affiliated to the University of Kerala to receive the status of CPE (College with Potential for excellence) from the UGC. It has been conferred with Autonomy status by the UGC from June 2014. 


Gender wise profile of students Fig 1

Qualitative Matrix

From the qualitative analysis it was found that the key posts in the college which includes Vice principal, Controller of Examinations, IQAC Coordinator, Associate NCC Officer, NSS Programme Officer, Council Secretary, Staff Secretary, Staff Advisors and Librarian were all occupied by female members. The Heads of 10 out of 18 departments were also female members. The girl students of the college get equal opportunities and there is no differentiation on the basis of gender. They are encouraged in all co-curricular activities and treated at par with boys. They participate in NCC\NSS\Sports\Arts and every club and extension activity of the college without discrimination. The institution doesn't in any way restrict girl students from wearing apparels of their choice with just a requirement that they should be modest. This

Observing the gender equality, the girls are provided with various facilities and special attention. The NCC unit for girls concentrates in developing their characters and qualities like comradeship, discipline, leadership, secular outlook and spirit of adventure. This unit focuses on outstanding achievements of the girls. The NSS\women cell motivates girls for their social responsibilities. Special waiting room is provided for the girls. They are also given self-defence training apart from lectures of eminent personalities relating to their holistic development.

Concluding Remarks

The quantitative and qualitative matrix indicates that there is fairness and gender equality in the institution. It is a fact that the women who make to Mar Ivanios flourish to the fullest as the alma meter does not differentiate its employees\students based on gender but focuses on producing intellectually trained, morally upright, socially committed, spiritually inspired and ecologically conscious young men and women.

REPORT ON GENDER EQUITY PROMOTION PROGRAMMES DURING THE PERIOD 2018-23

In consonance with the policy ideals of ensuring equality of gender and honour the ethos of Millennium development Goal No: 5 of the United Nations to which India is a party to, Mar Ivanios College initiated various measures.

Mar Ivanios College believes that Gender Equality is a continuous engagement entailing timely and phased interventions and it is our commitment to hold the ideals of equality as highest policy priority in all our development objectives.

The following are the measures that are enunciated as a part of achieving gender parity at both infrastructural and policy levels.

For the first time in the history of the college, a woman Principal has assumed office and under her leadership, the institution is striving towards attaining greater goals in academic excellence and comprehensive progress of the student community.

Gender sensitivity is imparted in all key areas of administration by appointing a woman Controller of Examinations, Librarian, and Office Superintendent and their contributions are of immense significance in highlighting the role of women in an institutions growth and evolution.



Most of the Heads of Departments who are responsible for the day-to-day administration of respective departments and academic as well as student related matters are women, and their leadership is an inspiration for the students.

The non-teaching staff, especially, the housekeeping staff that form the core of administrative mechanism of the college are also women.

The faculty members who are the backbone of the institution are predominantly female, and, in order to ensure employment parity and to ensure safety and security of women, a female security staff is also appointed.

The students' union, the primary organization that is led by students, features a prominent number of women office bearers and the Chairperson for the year 2021-22 was a woman and most of the Executive Committee are composed of women.

Apart from varied activities that are inclusive in outlook and practice, the college has further made infrastructural arrangements to reflect the approach.

The restroom complex for women in the college is built with sufficient facilities and is well illuminated and perimeter fencing is provided to enhance safety.



The college is also committed towards ensuring the rights of Divyang students, and a Divyang friendly restroom is also provided in the campus with ramp access, and railings.

With a vision to make access to menstrual products and to further idea of menstrual hygiene, which contributes to overall health and well-being of women, a sanitary napkin vending machine is provided in the campus.

A holistic approach towards augmenting the skills of women is reflected in the commitment of the college by functioning a Women's Cell that redefines leadership roles, volunteering initiatives and equipping them with








CANCER AWARENESS PROGRAMME








Talk on Health and Hygiene



A flea market was also organised where various participants could sell their crafts and food.






KERALA PIRAVI DAY CELEBRATION (01/11/2022)




WOMEN'S DAY (08/03/2023)
